ACCEPTED RECYCLABLES



ELECTRONICS

- COMPUTERS & MONITORS (Limit of 2)
- STEREOS, DVD PLAYERS, PHONES, VCRs, PRINTERS, SCANNERS.
- TELEVISIONS (Limit of 2)
Currently no disposal fee.



PLASTIC BAGS

- Clean, Dry plastic grocery bags. Also shrink wrap, dry cleaner bags, drink carton wraps.



USED TIRES

- AUTO / PICK UP (Limit 10)
\$1 off rim. \$2 on rim.
- TRACTOR (Limit 4 total)
Front tire: \$3. Rear tire: \$10.
- SEMI TRUCK TIRES (Limit: 4)
\$5 off rim. \$10 on rim.



FLUORESCENT BULBS

- LIMIT: 8 Tubes.



PAINTS

LIMIT: 10 gallons oil based. NO latex paint.



ACCEPTED RECYCLABLES



BATTERIES

- CAR BATTERIES
Must not be cracked. Cells must be capped.
- RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES
Rechargeable batteries are accepted. Please no alkaline batteries.



GLASS

- GLASS BOTTLES
All glass food and beverage bottles: clear, green, brown. Please rinse.



OIL, FILTERS, ANTIFREEZE

LIMIT: 5 gallons of motor oil.



REFRIGERANTS

- ACCEPTABLE ITEMS INCLUDE:
Refrigerators, air conditioners, freezers, dehumidifiers. Currently no disposal fee.

The following items **will not** be accepted:

- Fuel tanks
 - Window or plate glass
 - Paper / Cardboard that is wet
 - Alkaline batteries
- Please do not leave items after hours.
